500 Years Funchal City Award

1 - **The Madeira Island Radio Club – ARRM**; the **500 years commemorations Committee**, and the **Funchal City Hall**, and **ANACOM**, joined efforts to promote the commemorations of the 500 years of the Funchal City Foundation, in a medium term Award.

Funchal City was founded in the year of 1508, and it's the Capital city from Madeira Islands Archipelago, with about 200.000 inhabitants.

2 – The contacts, for the Award are valid from 01 of January 2008 to 31 December 2008.

3 – To get the Award, you need to have 250 points in contacts made with stations located in Madeira Island Archipelago. Each call can be worked once per Band/Mode per day.

A – The points will be awarded this way:

- Stations from Madeira Island Arch. Using the special prefixes (ex. CT9500XX, CT95XX, CQ9500XX, CQ95XX, CQ3500XX, CQ35XX etc) , will give 10 points for each contact,
- ARRM official Station (CS3MAD) – 15 points
- Any other Station located in Madeira Island no using the special prefix – 5 points

4 – This Award can be solicited in the following categories:

- Mixed
- Phone
- CW
- Digital
- VHF

The stations located in Madeira Islands can ask to ANACOM, permission to use a special call composed the following way:

- Prefix : CQ3, CQ9, CT9, CS9, plus the digit “5” or “500”, followed by the two letters of their personal call.
(Ex: - CT3AA – Can ask CQ95AA, CQ9500AA, CT95AA, CT9500AA, CQ35AA, CQ3500AA etc.)

These special call signs can be requested to ANACOM, for 7 days periods, and can be renewed everytime the operator wants until the end of the year, with at least one day of interval, in each licence, based on the present Regulations

6 – For the stations located in Madeira Island Arch. that wishes to get this Award, they must follow these particular Rules:

- For Operators of Class A ;
150 contacts with his own callsign or 100 contacts using the special prefixes announced in the present document. (The contacts must be made for stations located outside Madeira Islands)

- For Operators of Class B or less;
15 Contacts with stations outside Madeira Islands.
Or
Active participation on the ARRM HQ in one of the Operations that will be organizes related with this event, under the supervision of a Class A Operator.

7 – The Award can be asked in two Ways;

- Completely free, by sending your application, by e-mail to cs3mad@sapo.pt , or cs3mad@gmail.com . You will receive a confirmation message (not automatically) of the receipt of your Application. You will receive you Award by e-mail in the required format, that you can save it in your disk, or print in your printer.

Do not forget to send your e-mail in your application

- You can also ask the Award by normal mail. For that you must send us your application, with a SASE (A4 Format) and the amount of 5 Euros or 10 USD for expenses and shipment. The Address of ARRM can be easily found in www.qrz.com under the call CS3MAD .
